Know your neighbours (sourced from NZ Police booklet)

- The most important action you can take to make your place safer is to know your neighbours.
 Exchange contact details, discuss your crime safety concerns, and decide what you would do in an emergency.
- Let neighbours know when you are going to be away. Swap holiday addresses and phone numbers.
 Let each other know if visitors or tradespeople will be in your house while you are away.
- Question strangers, but don't say the neighbours are away. Write down their description, and note the time and date.
- Write down the registration numbers of unfamiliar vehicles moving slowly or stopping in the street.
- Report anything suspicious to your local police station.
- If you think a crime is being committed or someone is in serious danger, call the police immediately on 111.
